Thank you for choosing Northeast Mountaineering! We are looking forward to meeting you and taking you on an unforgettable adventure. At Northeast Mountaineering, we strive to give you the best rappelling experience possible. We will work hard to make your time with us a success from start to finish!

ON THE DAY OF YOUR ADVENTURE:

On the day of your scheduled rappel we will meet at 10:00AM sharp. If you are late, we cannot wait for you, as a courtesy to our other climbers. Please plan your travel accordingly. Don't forget to factor in pit stops, traffic, and navigation errors due to limited cell signals in the area.

WHAT YOU WILL NEED:

Please bring footwear that can get soaked as you will be standing in water at times. Also please wear synthetic materials that will dry out quicker than cotton such as wool, polyester, or techwick. We recommend that you wear a t-shirt and shorts because you will be wearing a harness and it may be uncomfortable in a swim suit. You will appreciate having a towel and a dry shirt for after the fun has ended. A small backpack to carry these items plus some food and water is recommended. We do offer a rental package that contains a wet suit top, water shoes, and rappelling gloves for \$25. We will provide helmets, harnesses, belay devices and technical equipment. Your rappel will run in the event of rain, however in certain circumstances heavy rain can result in the water flow rising too high to safely rappel. We always do our best to judge this, however it is difficult to predict the exact conditions and we may not find out until we arrive at the waterfall. Should we deem the waterfall unsafe, we will do our very best to offer you another time slot or your adventure will be rescheduled. We cannot offer a refund due to weather.

HOW TO FIND US:

For directions please visit www.bunkhouse.nemountaineering.com. We strongly encourage you to stay with us the night before your climb.

If you are rappelling in Massachusetts, we will meet at Crow Hill in Leominster State Park. To get there, follow Route 2 to exit 28. Follow Route 31S toward Princeton. Continue on Route 31S for approximately 2.4 miles. You will see a gated paved parking lot on your left. Continue passed this lot for 0.1 miles and you will see a small dirt lot on your right, We will meet here.

If you are rappelling in New Hampshire, we will meet at The Bunkhouse at Northeast Mountaineering in Bartlett, NH. 1054 Rt. 16. This address does not show up on GPS's, we are 1 mile north of Storyland on the same side of the road [Located across from the Glen Ledge Convenient Store and Gas Station].

GRATUITIES and OTHER COSTS:

Our guides are highly trained and have logged countless hours in the backcountry gaining the experience and knowledge it requires to become a guide for NEM. They never expect a gratuity, however they truly appreciate any sign of appreciation for what they do. A typical gratuity is approximately \$15-\$20/person/day.

Should you find yourself needing any piece of gear or clothing, we do have rental equipment. Please contact us or fill out a rental form ahead of time to arrange the appropriate rentals for your trip. Rentals are often an additional cost.

Unless you have ordered a NEM meal package, we do not provide food. Please plan to bring your own meals or dine out at any one of the amazing local restaurants.

For liability reasons, we do not offer transportation. Please plan to drive your car or carpool to the climbing areas.

THE BUNKHOUSE AT NORTHEAST MOUNTAINEERING

The Bunkhouse is a fully heated hostel-style community bunkroom. It offers a dry, warm, and cozy place to catch some rest before and after your adventure. The Bunkhouse does not have public showers, however there are quarter-operated showers 15 minutes down the road. BYOB. New Hampshire State Law prohibits underage drinking.
